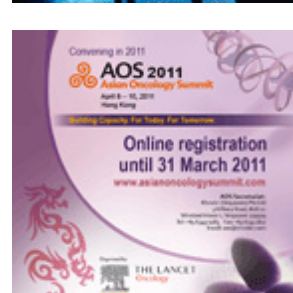

Following the appointment of Professor Alexander (Lex) Eggermont as Editor-in-Chief, a new Team of Editors has joined the *EJC*.
