He was a founding member of the Swiss Society for Medical Oncology and their first president. He served as president of the Swiss Institute for Applied Cancer Research from 1999 to 2005. He is member of the International Association for the Study of Lung Cancer (IASLC), where he served as chair of the fellowship committee. In ESMO he served as National Representative and chaired the ESMO Task Force on Guidelines from 1999 to 2005. Currently he is the chair of the ESMO Educational Committee and member of the ESMO Executive Committee. Since 2008 he is president of the International Breast Cancer Study Group (IBCSG).

He is editor in-chief of Lung Cancer and editor of Cancer Treatment Reviews.
